2. INTRODUCTION



Many activities were implemented to promote health and prevent covid-19 in order to ensure the containment of the coronavirus (2020-2021).

These actions took place in all Primary (EP) and Secondary (ES) Schools. These consisted in f the Teaching and Learning Process, mobilization and training in related issues, involving parents and/or guardians, managers, teachers, students and non-teaching staff (in coordination with the Health Services and Partners).



3. PEDAGOGICAL AND HEALTH ACTIONS



- The SAS platform (saseducacao.cov.mz) was created and disseminated to respond to the need to support students, guaranteeing the complementarity of learning, where video classes are recorded and broadcast, also focusing on students with special educational needs (SEN);
- Twenty one volunteer teachers were trained to teach on the SAS platform, and created platforms (whatsapp groups, websites, Google classroom, etc) with the inclusion of parents and guardians to monitor students and keep permanent interaction (EP and ES);
- Were produced 2787 handouts for the students to read and fill in a home;
- From health, training sessions were carried out, covering 1200 teachers and non-teachers staff;
- 213 lectures on Covid 19 prevention measures were held in schools and districts, accomplished by permanent monitoring;
- Good practices and prevention were provided to the students
- Face masks protection were distributed in different schools.
